TransQuest Tag & Tracing Solutions B.V. is a Netherlands-based integrator that provides RFID access and security solutions to a wide variety of clients and environments, including tracking systems for office buildings, museums, logistics operations, prisons and hotels.

Business Challenge

Alcatel-Lucent Nederland, wanted to update its access control system in order to better secure its facilities, improve security for its staff, and provide a better way to manage evacuations in the event of an emergency.

Solution

Alcatel-Lucent needed a reliable, hands-free solution to replace its existing magnetic card access control system. In addition to security, the new system had to provide time and attendance data to the human resources department at Alcatel-Lucent's offices in Rijswijk, The Netherlands. TransQuest Tag & Tracing Solutions has implemented an RFID-based solution at the facility that not only meets Alcatel-Lucent's security needs, but also provides real-time asset management functionality.

The solution, in place since 2005, combines the SmartTag software from UK-based Advanced Positioning Systems (APS) and Active RFID Tags and Readers from Wavetrend. Employee RFID-enabled photo ID badges provide time-stamped, hands- free access to the Alcatel-Lucent parking garage and offices. Readers on every floor detect and register the presence of these Tags, and can dynamically record their movements in the SmartTag software. Visitors to the building are also given temporary ID badges that provide controlled access to the facility.

In addition to the employee badges, audio-visual equipment (such as projectors), artwork, and company laptop computers are tagged with the Active RFID technology. Alcatel-Lucent can easily locate its assets, and alerts are triggered by the software system when unauthorized Tags enter the facility, or when a laptop leaves the premises with someone other than authorized personnel.

In the event of an emergency, Alcatel-Lucent is able to quickly locate all employees and visitors, and can rapidly organise a building evacuation.

It has improved employee safety by keeping the Alcatel-Lucent offices secure, and increased the effectiveness of the company's emergency evacuation plan.
